

## Solène Guillet, new AFNOR regional delegate

1<sub>er</sub>February 2022, Solène Guillet took up her duties as regional delegate of the AFNOR group in Burgundy-Franche-Comté, following Paule Nusa. Through her professional career focused on sustainable development, she intends to invest in the transitions of the territory and its stakeholders.

The AFNOR branch in Burgundy-Franche-Comté supports 1,600 companies and organizations in the region. Inaugurated in 2018, it contributes to the consolidation of the industrial fabric and its visibility, in particular by delivering training and certifications of international scope, such as ISO 9001 on the quality management system, ISO 14001 on the environmental management, or IATF 16949 on quality management in the automobile industry, historical sector. To support the region in its ecological transition, the AFNOR group also provides support in the implementation of an energy management system (ISO 50001) and helps to respond to the tertiary decree. The arrival of Solène Guillet marks an acceleration of the movement.

An adopted Franche-Comté for almost 25 years, Solène Guillet worked in particular at the Chamber of Trades and Crafts, then at the Regional Chamber of Commerce and Industry. Its job is to support companies and organizations in

risk management and environmental protection, she has carried out this in turn as project manager, advisor then division manager. A professional rise which has allowed him to promote eco-design, the fight against pollution, the energy transition, waste prevention, industrial and territorial ecology, the social responsibility of organizations, etc.


## Its formation
