The biannual meeting of those who embody quality in Occitanie will be held on December 5 at Toulouse Business School. Nearly 300 participants are expected.

The 4th edition of the #FQPO will be resolutely focused on the profession, function and quality practices, with two study presentations to kick off the day:

- 200 regional companies measured themselves against 19 indicators on how to manage and produce quality, and compared themselves with each other.
- Careers, salaries and developments in the quality profession: a new study carried out among 17,000 professionals will make it possible to draw up a detailed x-ray.



Insights from APEC and Pôle Emploi are expected to provide an overview of the challenges of this profession in the region.
