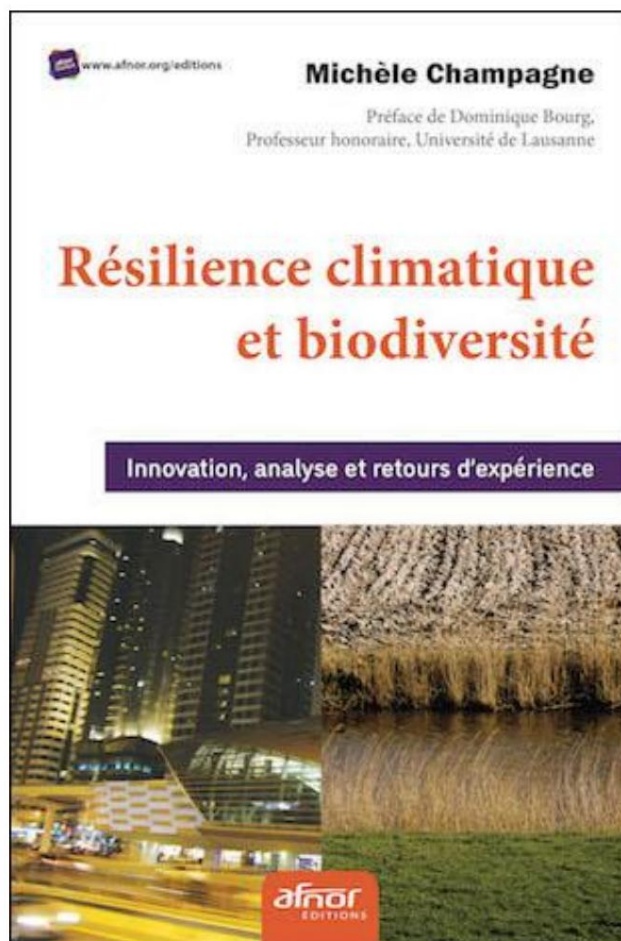

Climate change, the decline in biodiversity, economic imbalances between territories, so many issues which can only find answers through a collective initiative. How to achieve this? This is the whole mission of this book. By identifying formidable social, technological or entrepreneurial innovations, Michèle Champagne offers numerous feedback which constitutes avenues or solutions to respond to climate challenges and the decline of our planet's biodiversity.

SMEs or multinationals, local or territorial authorities, associations, architectural offices or design schools which renew urban practices, all these actors have the capacity for innovation to stimulate a dynamic of transition towards a new model of ecological and sustainable society.

This work presents their contribution to the ecological, economic and social transition. It is about energy, housing, town planning and industry, but also agriculture, permaculture and food.

Illustrated with numerous tables, graphs and boxes, the first part of the book presents the general framework of the transition.

The second part, the main one, presents the contributions of the actors in the form of detailed feedback. Through interviews, the author paints multiple portraits of actions on the ground which just need to be known and used as examples. Each action is linked to one or more of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), an internationally accepted and recognized benchmark, adopted within the framework of the UN.

Climate Resilience and Biodiversity is undoubtedly THE book for stakeholders and initiatives in terms of sustainability. Initiatives which all go in the right direction and which constitute all incentives to go further.
